**Hyde Park**  
**April 26-27**  
For the fifth year, NETAA will run a triple crown in New York. The mini tour starts at Ti-Yogi Bowman in Hyde Park, NY. From I-84, take Rt 9 north to Poughkeepsie. Turn right (18.7 miles) onto Pine Woods Rd. Continue onto E. Market St (0.6 miles). Turn left onto Hwy 9G toward Hyde Park. Take left on Mill Rd, go one block, over bridge, club on right.

**2nd Leg**  
**Hudson Falls**  
**F&G**  
**May 31-Jun 1**  
The second leg will be hosted by Hudson Falls Fish & Game. Directions: Take Rte. 87 North to exit 17N. Take Rte. 9 North to Rte. 197 East. Take Rte 197 E to Rte. 4 North to Hudson Falls. Take Rte. 196 East from Rte 4 and travel approx. 3 miles. Club is on the left.

**3rd Leg**  
**Gilbertsville**  
**July 26-27**  
The third and final leg will be hosted by Gilbertsville Rod & Gun. Directions: From I-88, take Route 8 north to route 51 north. From Route 51 take Cope's Corners Road to Gun Club Road. From here follow the signs (it will be well marked).

- ◆ Top 20 unqualified archers in each class at each of these events qualifies to compete in the NETAA World Championship (3-D round).
- ◆ Plaques awarded to top three places in each class at each event (based on participation).
- ◆ Overall New York 3-D Triple Crown Championship determined by total accumulated scores at all three events: Awards presented at the third leg.

MSR	Master	any archer over 62, freestyle, any sight, any style
SNR	Senior (50+)	(male & female) freestyle, any sight, any style
M-FS	Adult	(male) Freestyle, any sight, any style
M-FSL	"	(male) Freestyle limited, any sight, fingers
M-BFS	"	(male) Bowhunter Freestyle, max. 12" stabilizer, fixed pins, release.
M-BFSL	"	(male) Bowhunter Freestyle Limited, max. 12" stabilizer, fixed pins, fingers.
BH	"	Max 4 pins, screw in tip (min 80 gr.), one 12" stabilizer, min. 4" vanes/feathers.
RU	"	(male & female) Recurve unaided, max. 12" stabilizer, no sights, fingers.
LB	"	(male & female) longbow, 90# max. bow wt., no sight, fingers
L-SNR	"	ladies 50+, any style, any sight
F-FS	"	(female) Freestyle, any sight, any style.
F-BFS	"	(female) Bowhunter freestyle, max. 12" stabilizer, fixed pins (hunting sight).
Y-MFS	Youth (13-17)	(male) Freestyle, any sight, any style.
Y-FFS	"	(female) Freestyle, any sight, any style.
CUB	Cub 9-12 yrs.	(male & female) any equipment, any style.
PeeWee	Age 8 & under	(male & female) any equipment, any style.

### Divisions

MONEY (M-FS, M-BFS, F-FS classes only)  
OPEN DIVISION

### Arrows

Minimum 5 grains per pound (6 recommended)  
Minimum 80 grain points (including insert) in bowhunter classes

### Max 3-D distances per Class (special notes)

PEWEE: 15 yards  
CUB, RU, & LB: 30 yards  
M-FS, M-FSL, & M-BFS: 50 yards  
All other: 40 yards

### Young Adult Classes

These classes will be recognized at National level shoots, at regional level and below, all archers 13-17 years old will be considered youths.

### Equipment Classes

FS Freestyle. Any sight, stabilizer, style

FSL Freestyle Limited. Any sight or stabilizer, fingers only.

BFS Bowhunter Freestyle. Maximum 5 fixed pins. Maximum 12" stabilizer. Release.

BFSL Bowhunter Freestyle Limited. Maximum 5 fixed pins. Maximum 12" stabilizer. Fingers only.

BH Competitors winning a State level (or above) competition must move up a class

LB 90# max. No sights. Fingers only. One anchor point.
