NETAA kicks off the first leg of the SOUTHERN Triple Crown at Delaware County Field & Stream in Brookhaven, PA. Not only is this a great facility, it is close to both Delaware and Maryland. Directions: Take I-76 to I-76 E. Take I-476 S exit (#28 A) toward Chester. Take US-1 (exit 3) toward Springfield. Keep right at fork in ramp onto US-1 S. Merge onto US-1/E Baltimore Pike. Turn Left onto S Pennell Rd (PA 452). Turn left onto W. Knowlton Rd. Turn right onto Chester Creek Road

**1st Leg

The second leg will be hosted by the Limerick Bowman. Directions: From PA Pike, take Valley Forge exit and follow signs to Rt 202 South (stay to the right). Exit 202 onto Rt 422 West. Follow Rt 422 W approx. 15 miles, exit Limerick/Linfield. Bear right onto Lewis Rd. At stop (1 mile) turn right onto Ridge Pike. At light turn left onto Swamp Pike. Turn right (2.5 miles) on Stienmetz Rd. Turn Right (1/2 mile) to Bragg Rd. Club on left.

The third and final leg will be hosted by Lincoln Park Archers at the Newark YM/WCA Camp Henry Dawson. Take Rt. 287 to exit 47, then Rt. 202 North for 2 miles, then left on Jacksonville Rd. Range is one mile on left. Note: 202N turns into Main Rd, Stay on Main Rd. Do not go under any underpasses.

Minimum 5 grains per pound (6 recommended)

PEWEE: 15 yards
CUB, RU, & LB: 30 yards
M-FS, M-FSL, & M-BFS: 50 yards
All other: 40 yards

Young Adult Classes

These classes will be recognized at National level shoots, at regional level and below, all archers 13-17 years old will be considered youths.

Equipment Classes

FS Freestyle. Any sight, stabilizer, style
FSL Freestyle Limited. Any sight or stabilizer, fingers only.
BFS Bowhunter Freestyle. Maximum 5 fixed pins. Maximum 12" stabilizer. Release.
BFSL Bowhunter Freestyle Limited. Maximum 5 fixed pins. Maximum 12" stabilizer. Fingers only.
BH Competitors winning a State level (or above) competition must move up a class
LB 90# max. No sights. Fingers only. One anchor point.
